# THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM GHS and SHS Ready to Kick Off Season

First-year Griffin High School Head Football Coach, Antonio Andrews, and sixth-year Spalding High School Head Football Coach, Nick Davis, joined us on Thursday to speak on their upcoming gridiron seasons. GHS and SHS are not in the same region this year but will kick off their regular seasons next Friday, August 26<sup>th</sup>, with their cross-town rivalry. Kickoff is at 7:30 in Griffin's Memorial Stadium. Coach Nick Davis told those gathered that he had 15 starters from last year's 10-2 team returning this year (8 on offense, 7 on defense). "Expectations are high this year because of our 10-2 season last year," he said. He said that he purposely scheduled some perennial good football teams this year. As he noted, "We were not playoff ready last year in our game against Woodward Academy." He hopes the tougher schedule will challenge his players and make them a stronger team if they do advance into the playoffs. He said that Griffin High, Jonesboro, Lovejoy, and Houston County will be very tough opponents. Houston County has the consensus top quarterback in the state who has already committed to UGA. Coach Antonio Andrews is excited about the upcoming "We had a magnificent summer," he said. season. GHS has 120 players on their roster with 10 returning starters (3 on defense, 7 on offense) from last year's team. He anticipates having a strong passing attack this year coming off three very competitive 7 v 7 events with other high schools during the summer. Both coaches thanked their administrations and the community for their support of their programs, and they invited all to come out to the games. GHS will host Spalding on August 26<sup>th</sup> and will have home games on September 2 (LaGrange), September 8

(Upson-Lee), September 30 (Starr's Mill), October 7 (Morrow), and November 4 (Riverdale). SHS will be at home on September 9 (Lovejoy), September 16 (Southwest Macon), September 22 (Houston Co), October 21 (Howard), October 28 (Perry), and November 4 (Upson-Lee).
