THIS WEEK'S PROGRAM District Governor Ray Visits Club

District 6900 Governor Raymond Ray, Jr., visited the Rotary Club of Griffin this week with a social at the home of Jackie and William Wilson on Wednesday evening, participating in our monthly Board Meeting on Thursday morning, and being our featured speaker during our noontime meeting. Following a video of Rotary International President John Germ on the importance of growing and retaining membership in Rotary, DG Raymond underscored that building our numbers will increase our power to serve in our own community and in our world. He said that his job as DG is to support the individual club presidents in the District. He noted the strength of District 6900, which is now rated among the top ten districts in Rotary International, comes from the individual clubs. "We believe that we can change our world for people who we may or may not know," he added. DG Raymond described a District Service Project aimed at honoring

all those who serve, either in the military or as first responders. He asked all Rotarians to personally thank those in service in our community. He then identified Sonny Hunt as the member of our club who had entered military service first among all those in attendance. Sonny was presented with a lapel pin that DG Raymond asked Sonny to wear in honor of all veterans in our Club. He encouraged all to remain committed to the eradication of polio in the world and to ending human trafficking. "It is a commitment," he said. "And, not just a goal." He continued by saying, "We Rotarians have service in our hearts. Serving Humanity is another way of saying Service Above Self." The Centennial Rotary International Convention will convene in Atlanta over June 10-14, 2017. He expects 45,000 Rotarians to attend, and he is encouraging District 6900 Rotarians to volunteer in various capacities during the meeting to show our Southern Hospitality to the world. He also explained the format of District Conference in April which will be held aboard a cruise ship. Club President Janice Wallace commemorated the District Governor's visit with the citation that a square inch of the Inches for Arch portrait has been purchased in honor of DG Raymond. The portrait has been commissioned in support of the Atlanta Convention and the Rotary Foundation.
